ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO PARTIALLY LIFT STAY OF ADMINISTRATIVE
PROCEEDINGS

Complaint Counsel and Respondents Corpay, Inc., formerly known as FleetCor Technologies, Inc., and Ronald Clarke, having moved jointly to both (i) partially lift the stay of this administrative action and (ii) withdraw this matter from adjudication in order to enable the Commission to consider a proposed consent agreement; and

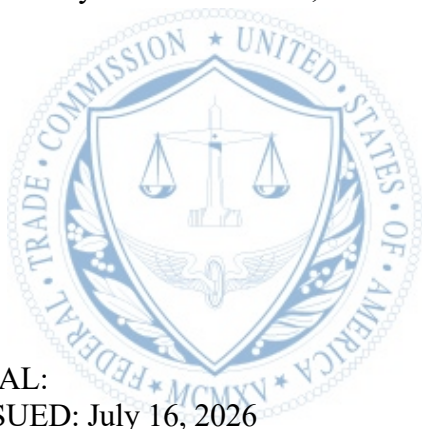
Complaint Counsel and Respondents, having submitted a proposed consent agreement containing a proposed Decision and Order, executed by Respondents and by the Bureau of Consumer Protection and approved by the Director of the Bureau of Consumer Protection that, if accepted by the Commission, would resolve the claims against Respondents in their entirety (“Consent Agreement”);

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Joint Motion is **GRANTED**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the stay of this matter is partially lifted to permit the matter to be withdrawn from adjudication; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission directs the Secretary to issue an order withdrawing this matter in its entirety from adjudication pursuant to Rule 3.25(c) of the Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(c) to permit a determination by the Commission with respect to the proposed Consent Agreement, pursuant to Rule 3.25(f), 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(f).
