ORDER WITHDRAWING THE MATTER FROM ADJUDICATION PURSUANT TO
RULE 3.25(C)

The Commission, having issued the Order Lifting the Stay of Administrative Proceedings in response to the Joint Motion to Lift Stay of Administrative Proceedings and Withdraw the Matter from Adjudication Pursuant to Rule 3.25(c); and

Complaint Counsel and Respondents, having submitted a proposed consent agreement containing a proposed Decision and Order, executed by Respondents and by the Bureau of Consumer Protection and approved by the Director of the Bureau of Consumer Protection that, if accepted by the Commission, would resolve the claims against Respondents in their entirety (“Consent Agreement”);

IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 3.25(c) of the Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(c), that this matter be, and hereby is, withdrawn in its entirety from adjudication, and that all proceedings before the Administrative Law Judge be, and hereby are, stayed, to permit a determination by the Commission with respect to the proposed Consent Agreement, pursuant to Rule 3.25(f), 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(f); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 3.25(b) of the Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(b), that the proposed Consent Agreement shall not be placed on the public record unless and until it is accepted by the Commission.
